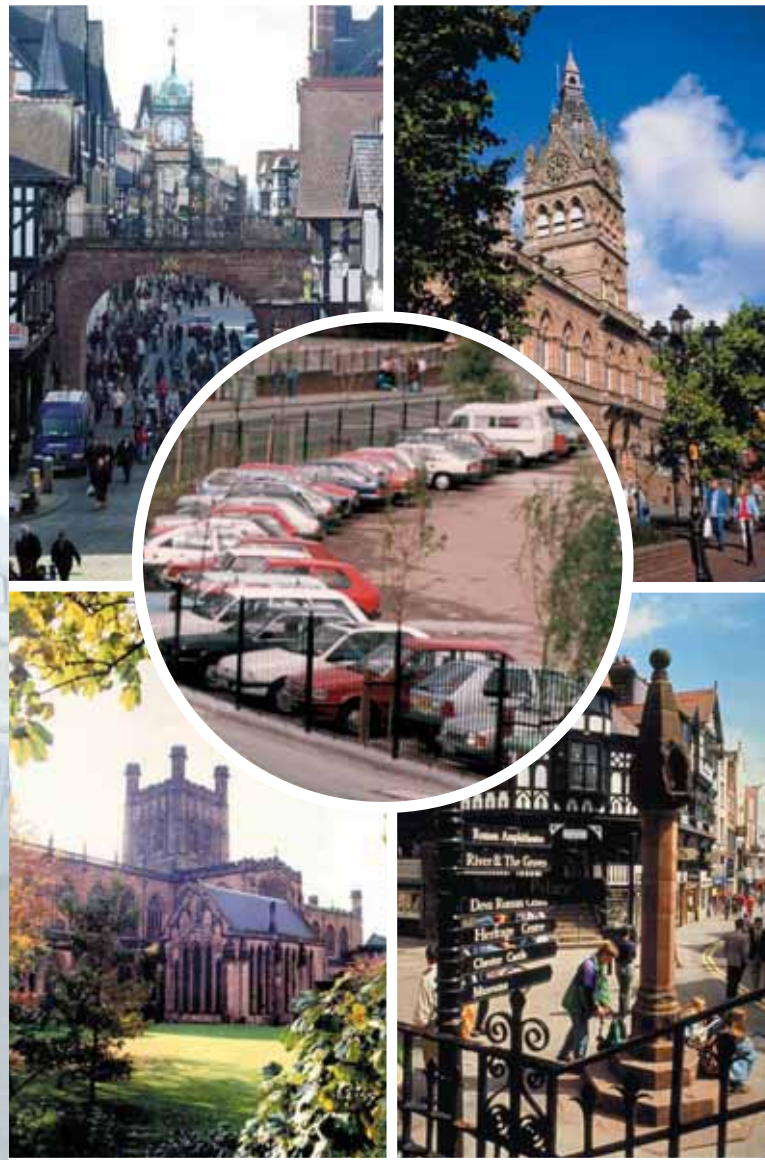

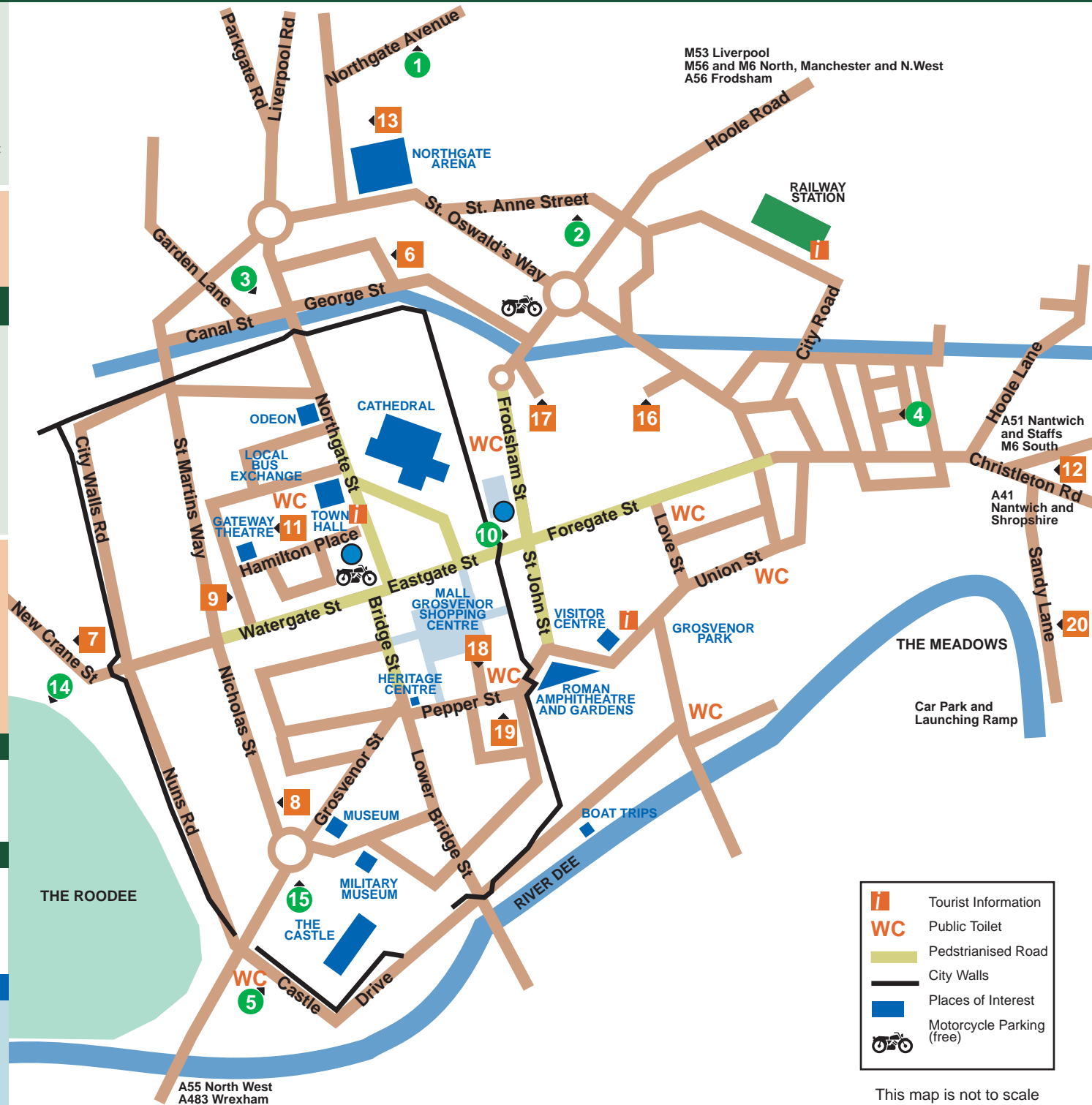
PARKING FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES
